View from the coach: the U.S. Capitol, Kennedy Center, Library of Congress, Supreme Court, House and Senate Office Buildings, Federal Triangle, Pennsylvania Avenue, The White House, capitol Reflecting Pool, Georgetown and Marine Corps (Iwo Jima) Memorial. Length of the tour is 3 hours. Pick up at the hotel. Tour will be held on Saturday, October 9, 2010 at 8:00 p.m. and the cost is \$45 per person.
